

## SCHOOL DISTRICT OF MARSHALL NEWS RELEASE

The Marshall Board of Education met in regular session June 21, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. in the Central Office. Seven board members; three administrators; Eric Crump, representing Democrat News; and Ken Lewellen, representing KMMO were present.

The board approved the minutes of the May 24 regular board meeting, the June bills totaling \$617,663.53, final approval of bus routes, and the monthly financial report.

Dr. Noah reported work on the track at MHS will begin at the end of June or beginning of July. Our maintenance personnel have installed drainage tile in preparation of work being done. When the work begins the track will not be available to the public and it is expected for it to be completed by the end of July, weather permitting.

Dr. Noah also reported three bids were received for the roofing project at Eastwood Elementary School. Haskins Services, Inc. will be completing the project for \$106,298. The original budget for this project was \$131,450.

Caleb Crawford made an official request that the Marshall Board of Education name the tennis courts at Marshall High School after Susan Carney, Head Coach. The board approved his request to name the courts the Susan Carney Tennis Complex.

Dr. Noah reported each year the district takes activity accounts, such as student activities, lunch, etc., and zeros out those that have a negative balance. This is an accounting item and it keeps those accounts from showing a build up of negative funds over a number of years. The positive funds are not zeroed out. The board approved to zero out all negative activity accounts.

Dr. Noah also reported at the end of the fiscal year, which is June 30, our auditors request that the Board of Education make a motion to actualize all revenues and expenditures for the past year. The Annual Secretary of the Board report will be completed in July and this document summarizes all revenues and expenditures. The board approved to actualize all revenues and expenditures for the 2010-11 fiscal year. The board also approved to utilize the Guaranteed Tax Base/Line Transfer Rule and transfer funds from the incidental to the capital projects budget necessary to fund capital improvements.

The preliminary budget for 2011-12 was presented to the board. The total estimated revenue is \$22,440,570 and the total estimated expenditures are \$22,438,709 which results in an estimated positive budget of \$1,861. The board approved the preliminary 2011-12 budget as presented.

In executive session the board accepted the resignation of Maleri Snyder, BMS Special Education Teacher. They approved the employment of Tracy Crumbaugh, Adult Business Computer Technology Teacher; Jessica Hale, BMS Special Education; Josh Clausen, Early Childhood Para and Freshman Football Coach; and Linda King, Activities/Transportation Secretary.

The meeting adjourned at 7:55 p.m. The next regular board meeting of the Marshall Board of Education is July 26 at 7:00 p.m.
