What You Can Do to Stay Healthy

There are everyday actions people can take to stay healthy.

- × Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
- × Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hands cleaners are also effective.
